IntelliVoice 4

Passenger Compartment Connections

- 1. Connect one end of the CliffNet Dataport Interconnect cable to the alarm system control unit and connect the other end in to the IntelliVoice 4 module.
- 2. Disable the siren that is connected to the security system by disconnecting the YELLOW wire or BLACK TWINLEAD wire (depending on the type of siren connected to the security system).
- 3. Connect any unused auxiliary output wire (e.g., auxiliary A) from the control unit of the security system to the GRAY/VIOLET wire from the 7-pin connector on the IntelliVoice 4. When this wire is pulsed to ground, it changes the siren setting from voice mode to chirps mode.
- 4. Connect the GRAY TWINLEAD from the 7-pin connector to the internal diagnostics speaker. Mount the siren securely, making sure it does not interfere with vehicle operation.

Engine Compartment Connections

- 1. Connect the BLACK wires to the battery negative cable clamp.
- 2. Connect the RED wire from the 7-pin connector to the 5 amp fuse at the battery positive cable clamp.
- 3. Connect the BLACK TWINLEAD from the 7-pin connector to the external speech/siren speaker. Using the supplied screws, mount the siren pointing downward to avoid water ingress and other damage.

Install the Dual-Zone Proximity Sensor 4

If the security system you are installing the IntelliVoice 4 to does not already have a dual-zone proximity sensor, you must add a Dual-Zone Proximity Sensor 4.

- 1. Follow the instructions provided with the Dual-Zone Proximity Sensor 4 for mounting location and installing into the vehicle.
- 2. Connect the GREEN armed output from the security system control unit to the Dual-Zone Proximity sensor.
- 3. Connect the ORANGE sensor input from the security system control unit to the Dual-Zone Proximity sensor.
- 4. Connect the BLUE warning zone output wire from the Dual-Zone Proximity sensor to the BLUE wire from the 7-pin connector of the IntelliVoice 4 7-pin connector.
- 5. Connect the RED wire from the Dual-Zone Proximity sensor to the 5 amp fuse at the battery positive cable clamp.

Sensor Adjustment


To adjust the sensitivity of the optional Dual-Zone Proximity Sensor 4, follow the instructions that were provided with the sensor. If the security system came with a proximity sensor, follow the security system's installation instructions for sensor adjustment.
