System maintenance

This system needs no specific maintenance beyond remote control battery replacement. The 2-way remote is powered by one 1.5V AAA battery. The 1-way remote is powered by two 3V, CR2016 batteries.

Battery Level Indicator, 2-way

The Battery Level indicator has four level indicators that serve as a visual indication of battery charge. When the battery reaches a low charge level that requires replacement, the remote control generates a single notification chirp, and the Battery Level indicator flashes continuously.

Remote control functions

The LCD remote control buttons are used to send commands to the system. The descriptions below reflect the standard configuration for this system. The buttons can be custom configured for the user's specific needs by the installer.*

2- way and 1- way

- Press and release a to lock the doors and arm the vehicle.
- Press and release 🖆 to unlock the doors and disarm the vehicle.
- Press and release AUX then press and release AUX then press and release and hold for approximately two seconds to activate an optional auxiliary function such as trunk release.

The auxiliary output controls_

- Press and hold in for two seconds, to activate Panic.
- Press and release and simultaneously to activate an auxiliary convenience or expansion option.

Government Regulations

Remote Controls

Receiver antenna
